

EEA Grants Outgoing Mobilities for Studies from West University of Timișoara

How do I apply?

The **EEA Grants- “Education, Scholarships, Apprenticeships and Youth Entrepreneurship”, 2014-2012**, allows **students enrolled full-time at West University of Timișoara** to take up study mobilities at partner universities within the European Economic Area.

The objectives of these study mobilities are the following:

- To offer students the opportunity to discover the advantages of a study experience in other European countries from an educational, linguistic and cultural point of view;
- To contribute to the development of human resources made up by young, qualified, open-minded and internationally experienced future professionals.

You can benefit from up to 3 months (or 1 term) to 12 months of study mobility at each academic level (B.A., M.A., PhD.) within projects under the umbrella of EEA Grants- **“Education, Scholarships, Apprenticeships and Youth Entrepreneurship”, 2014-2012, programme**

You can benefit from the EEA Grants- **“Education, Scholarships, Apprenticeships and Youth Entrepreneurship”, 2014-2012**, even if you have already pursued an Erasmus+ mobility previously, during the same cycle of study as long as you do not exceed the 12 month mobility period appointed for each academic cycle.

Why choose the **“Education, Scholarships, Apprenticeships and Youth Entrepreneurship”, 2014-2012, programme**?

- You have the opportunity to study in a totally different education system than the one you are accustomed to;
- You get to know another country, culture and language;
- You will get in contact with thousands of foreign students from all over the world;
- You can spend your term studying as well as travelling during your spare time;
- You can do your research for the B.A., M.A. or PhD. papers at the best universities / libraries chosen by yourself;
- You get financing;
- You can add to your CV the experience acquired for your future career;
- Employers demand international experience.

Who can apply?

In what West University of Timișoara is concerned, the conditions applied in the case of study mobilities within the **“Education, Scholarships, Apprenticeships and Youth Entrepreneurship”, 2014-2012, programme** are the following:



- You are a student of West University of Timișoara and have finished the 1st year of B.A. at the moment of departure;
- You have an average of minimum 7 on your previous academic years;
- You have passed all your exams by the time of your departure;
- Knowledge of English is a must

Mobilities for students with special needs

The **“Education, Scholarships, Apprenticeships and Youth Entrepreneurship”, 2014-2012, programme** particularly encourages students with special needs to benefit from international mobility. Students with special needs can benefit from additional (financial) support, in order to carry out the respective mobility in optimal conditions.

Annually, starting with the 2013/2014 academic year, students with special needs from the Western University of Timisoara have benefited from international mobilities

Students with special needs interested in conducting an international mobility are encouraged to contact the Department of International Relations of the Western University of Timisoara.

Where can I do my study mobility?

In what this component of the **“Education, Scholarships, Apprenticeships and Youth Entrepreneurship”, 2014-2012, programme** is concerned, the mobilities dedicated to students are realized on the basis of a bilateral agreement between WUT and the partner university. Available destinations for mobilities will be available during each selection period, every year. Stay tuned!

We recommend you visit the sites of the universities you are interested in so as to find more information about the available study programmes, as well as about practical aspect linked to day-to-day life, subsistence costs, and so on.

When and for how long?

A study mobility within the **“Education, Scholarships, Apprenticeships and Youth Entrepreneurship”, 2014-2012, programme** can be of 3 months (or 1 term) up to 12 months of study mobility per academic cycle (B.A., M.A., PhD.).

Do I receive a scholarship?

The financial aid for a student mobility is of 1200 euros/month (unit cost)

If you are the beneficiary of a merit / study / social scholarship at the WUT, you will still receive it during your mobility.

Are my studies recognized upon my return home?

The agreements between the WUT and the partner universities have been established exactly because there are similar courses at these institutions, which helps with the recognition of your studies. Depending on what is studied at the WUT during your mobility, you will apply for the partner university. For an accurate recognition, the Departmental Coordinator from your faculty (WUT) will help you decide.

How is the selection done?

In order to benefit from a study mobility within the **“Education, Scholarships, Apprenticeships and Youth Entrepreneurship”, 2014-2012, programme** during the 2019-2019 academic year, you have to submit your file, at the main secretariat of the faculty, between 30 September – 18 October, containing the following:

- Certificate specifying the average marks of your previous academic years;
- CV;
- Motivation letter to justify the choice of host university ;
- Language proficiency certificate (from the authorized chairs) or other recognized diplomas; such is not the case for students already studying the respective language as part of their academic curricula;
- A written request addressed to the Dean (specifying the faculty, the section, the year, the university for which you apply and the subjects you will study during your mobility).

Between the 21st and the 25th of October 2019 will be held the internal selection of candidates (evaluation of the file and interview), after which, on the 25th of October 2019 appeals may be lodged and then the final results will be displayed.

Language tests?

If you do not have a language proficiency certificate in English, you can undergo an evaluation at the Faculty of Letters, History and Theology. The fee is 20 lei to be paid on the day of the exam. The inscriptions for the test are done at room 228.

Students who study or have studied in English are exempt of any test.
