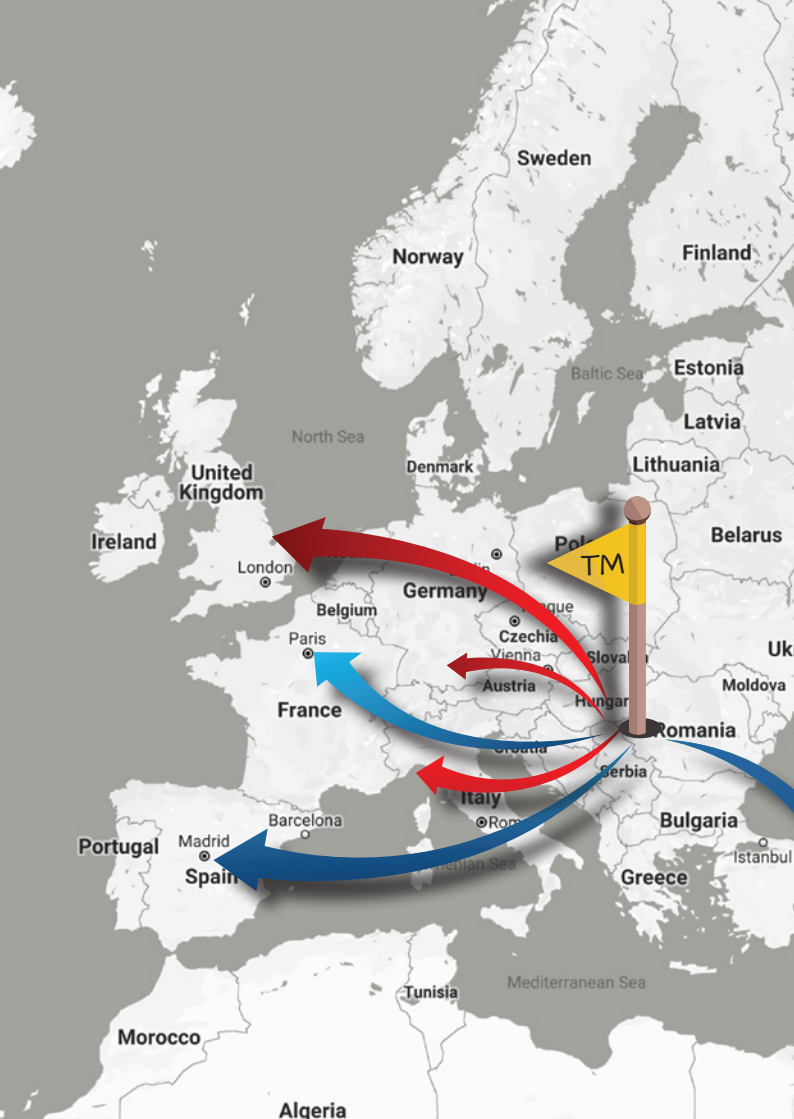

To be legible for admission, we need you to provide us the following documents:

- ▶ **Application Form;**
- ▶ **The studies documents** (legally certified copies and translations of previous diplomas and Transcripts of Records);
- ▶ **Birth certificate** (legally certified copy and translation);
- ▶ **Copy of the passport;**
- ▶ **Medical certificate;**
- ▶ **Marriage license;**
- ▶ **Copy of the document attesting the residency abroad;**
- ▶ **Copy of the language certificate;**
- ▶ **Complete contact form;**
- ▶ **Copy of receipt for 75 EURO** for the application fee.

1. DIR*:

- ▶ Registers, verifies and approves the content of the admission files
- ▶ Sends the file to faculty
- ▶ Communicates with the candidates

2. WUT FACULTIES:

- ▶ Organize the admission based on the admission file
- ▶ Send the results of the admission to the Department of International Relations

3. DIR:

- ▶ Centralizes the admission results
- ▶ Sends the approved files to the Ministry of National Education for the final results and communicates with the Ministry about the admission

4. THE MINISTRY OF NATIONAL EDUCATION:

- ▶ Issues the Letters of Acceptance for Studies in Romania and sends them to the Department of International Relations or rejects the requests in this sense in exceptional situations

5. DIR:

- ▶ Sends the Letters of Acceptance to the candidates and informs them concerning the enrollment process, obtaining the study visa etc.
- ▶ Communicates with the Faculty regarding the enrollment of the admitted candidates or supports the Faculty with different necessary reports, if applicable

Admission Calendar

(July or September - will be checked at the faculty directly)

Recognition of Studies

Calendar *(at least one month before the admission in July or September)*

Citizens of the E.U., European Economical Region and Swiss Confederation family members, subsidiary protection and refugees and Romanians with studies abroad must apply for admission under the same condition and in the same period as the Romanian students, for all study programmes and levels (B.A., M.A., PhD) within the 11 faculties of West University of Timișoara. The admission session will take place in July (for Bachelor and Master programmes) and in September for PhD studies.

A second session may be organized in September for B.A. and M.A. programmes, subject to available places. Each faculty will decide the calendar dates, the regulation and the necessary documents for each admission session. The Department of International Relations can only assist you into obtaining the Certificate from the National Centre for Recognition and Equivalence of Diplomas.

The rest of the documents needed for admission along with details concerning the form of examination can be found on each faculty's website or by contacting the faculty directly. The study fees for E.U., European Economic Area and Swiss Confederation citizens are the same as for Romanian students (including the Preparatory Year in Romanian Language) and are to be paid in Romanian currency (approximately 3000 Lei). The fees may be updated every year and posted on the website.

ADMISSION STEPS FOR EU COUNTRIES

- 1.** The candidates inform themselves at the secretary/ on the website of the faculty where they wish to be admitted at concerning the admission requirements.
- 2.** The candidates submit the file for the recognition of their previous studies from abroad at the Department of International Relations at least one month before the admission in July/September. Even so, the sooner they apply, the better.
- 3.** Once they have a Certificate of Recognition, the candidates prepare the admission file requested by the faculty.
! The Certificate of Recognition is only one document from the admission file which the candidates need to provide the secretary of the faculty with. The Certificate of Recognition is the only document from the admission file that can be obtained with the support of the Department of International Relations in approximate 30 working days.
- 4.** The candidates submit their admission files at the secretary of the faculty.
- 5.** The candidates sit the exams/interviews organized by the faculty.
- 6.** The candidates wait for the results.
- 7.** The candidates confirm their place (if the case) once they know the results.
- 8.** The candidates enroll and submit the original documents requested by the faculty.

9. If the issuing of the Certificate of Recognition is delayed and it is obtained after the admission session in July or September, the Department of International Relations will provide the candidate with a provisional document replacing the Certificate of Recognition until it arrives from the Ministry of National Education.

10. The Certificate of Recognition can either be included in the admission file in July or September (if it arrives on time) or shall be taken by the candidates at the secretary of the faculty when it arrives at the Department of International Relations. The deadline of adding the Certificate of Recognition to the initial admission documents is settled by each faculty. The Department of International Relations informs the candidates when the Certificate of Recognition arrives from the Ministry of National Education and it depends on the candidates to pick it up and take it to the secretary of the faculty where they were admitted at.

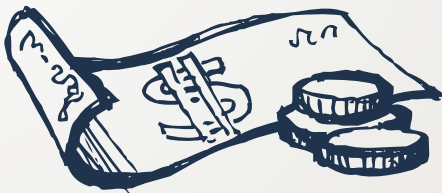
! For the Preparatory Year in Romanian language, the study fee is in the same amount as a year of tuition in the field of studies that the candidate decides to apply for after graduating this course.

For the Preparatory Year followed by medical studies, the tuition fee is in the amount of **2880 €**, whereas for the Preparatory Year followed by studies in the field of studies of “Architecture”, the tuition fee is in the amount of approximately **3150 €** and, for film studies, of approximately **8550 €**.

The tuition fees for third E.U citizens per month shall be multiplied with 9 months for a total amount per academic year.

Tuition Fees for E.U. citizens

For EU citizens, the tuition fees are the same as those applied for the Romanian students, of approximately 700 € per academic year (including the preparatory year in Romanian language).





Scholarships

The Romanian state offers scholarships to international students, either based on bilateral agreements with the country of origin where the applicant is coming from or based on academic results after the first year of study in Romania.

!!!Renting an Apartment in the City

The costs for renting an Apartment in Timișoara vary between 150 and 300 EUR, depending on the area you find the apartment that you would like to rent, and the number of rooms it has. Usually, apartments closer to the city center are more expensive than those near the outskirts of the town.

When You Arrive in Timișoara

If you are a E.U. citizen you can enter Romania with your ID document (a valid travel document e.g. passport, or another document certifying your identity and citizenship). Students from outside the European Union will need a visa and a passport.

Foreign citizens who stay in Romania for more than three months continually, and that are accepted and have registered for studies at a Romanian university, must register their stay (especially citizens from third E.U. countries), in this purpose, to the Romanian Authority for Foreigners, Timiș county, with the following documents:

About Timișoara

The third largest city in Romania (about 350,000 inhabitants), Timișoara has the charm of a small town and the opportunities of a big city. Situated in the Western part of the country, Timișoara is the capital of Timiș county, which borders Serbia and Hungary.

Symbol of the 1989 Revolution against the communist regime, Timișoara has had a turbulent history. Now, it is a multicultural city, where Germans, Hungarians, Serbs, Jews, etc. live side by side with the Romanians.

The city has plenty of outstanding monuments and buildings: the Orthodox Cathedral, the Roman Catholic Dome, the Huniade Castle, the Old Town Hall, the Bastion, the Union Square etc. It is the only European city with three public theatres in three different languages (Romanian, German and Hungarian). It also has an Opera house, a symphonic orchestra and many art galleries and museums.

Timișoara is an important academic center, with four public universities: the West University of Timișoara, the Polytechnic University, "Victor Babeș" University of Medicine and Pharmacy and the University of Agricultural Sciences and Veterinary Medicine of Banat.

Our city is a modern, cosmopolitan one, guided by the following motto: „Unity in Diversity”.
