

Third International Week Marketing Department University Institute of Technology Angers 17th-20th May

It is our pleasure to invite you to the third edition of International Week, organized by the department of Marketing of the University Institute of Technology of Angers from the 17^{th} to the 20^{th} of May 2016.

The event is designed to raise an intercultural awareness among students through the creation of an international learning environment. It also aims to strengthen our international networks by exchanging with the representatives of our partner universities in an extra-curricular context. This week will also be open to non-partner universities willing to contribute to our activities.

International Week will take the form of a series of lectures, seminars and workshops, and events organized by our guests. As regards to the content, intercultural topics as well as topics related to the fields of marketing and management will be welcome. Participants can cover topics related to their field of expertise or to a particular aspect of the social, economic and cultural life of their country. Topics in previous editions included tourism in Ireland, the Scottish referendum, e-maketing in Portugal, traditional German food festivals, e-activism, adapting multinational's advertising campaigns, American cultural icons, communication in the digital age, Spanish olive oil markets, marketing yoga and the economic crisis in Spain.

International week is targeted at first-year tertiary students. Our main goal is to familiarize students with the teaching methods of our partner universities and to encourage them to study abroad within their degree program. Therefore, we do not expect the material covered to be highly technical or in-depth. Interactive activities and workshops are most welcome.

Participants will be asked to give 4 to 5 lectures, seminars, workshops or tutorials on subjects of their choice but with an intercultural perspective. The students will then be challenged to present projects related to the participant's presentations using their skills in marketing and new technologies.



Participants will also be asked to participate in a Study Abroad Fair to help promote student exchanges to their home institution. In addition, a session will be held with the participants to discuss the possibility for joint projects, and distance teaching opportunities.

If you intend to come with some of your students, please let us know their number so that we can arrange for their accommodation on the campus and their program during the week.

It is anticipated that your home institution will meet travel expenses and additional hotel nights from its Erasmus staff mobility budget.

The University Institute of Technology of Angers will provide lunches and a welcome dinner for the visiting academics. They will be invited to a guided tour of the Cointreau distillery production site and bar for a unique tasting experience as well as a visit of the Cité des object connectés.
