- Number of participants is limited to 20 colleagues . Staff of ECIU Universities have selection priority.
- UAB undertakes a selection process to guarantee the selected participants best match with the objectives of the International Staff Week.
- Confirmation of selected and non-selected participants will be sent the **5th July**.
- Unfortunately, for capacity reasons we are unable to accept staff for job shadowing or individual training visits out of the ESW scheme.
