Virtual Component Description:

During the virtual component, the participating students will have the opportunity to get to know each other, to present their home universities and university cities and solve initial group tasks. In doing so, they can find common ground that will help them to solve the group tasks during the further activities in the mobility phase. The tasks completed and the topics discussed relate to aspects of multiculturalism in everyday student life at the three universities. They serve as preparation for the workshops in Timişoara, which deal with multiculturalism in Banat, with the ethnic groups living in Banat and their languages, literature and linguistic and cultural contacts. They will be tutored for this purpose by the BIP coordinators.

1. Planned activities during virtual component:

The first two online meetings take place before the mobility, the third serves as a follow-up.

1st online meeting:

- familiarisation activities
- brief presentations of the universities and university cities, must-see-places in Warszawa, Weimar and Timişoara
- building the first international teams and solving of first interactive individual and group tasks on multiculturalism

2nd online meeting:

- presentation of the obtained results and the solved individual and group tasks
- workshop on multilingualism in Romania, Poland and Germany
- distribution of tasks for the presence phase

3rd online meeting:

- final discussions and conclusions on the mobility phase, the activities and workshops from Timişoara
- presentations of the completed interactive group tasks from the mobility phase.
