Dear Colleagues and Partners,

*We are pleased to announce the **BIP Cybersecurity in Public Service** which will be held at the Ludovika University of Public Service in Budapest, Hungary, **between 26 and 30 May 2025**, with a virtual session to take place the week after.*

The aim of the program is to provide an insight into the basics of cybersecurity. Students will learn about the evolution of the cyberspace threat environment and the development of the information security and cybersecurity profession from the prehistory of computing. They will learn the basic conceptual principles that are frequently encountered in the field. In doing so, the lectures will also cover the most important information security protection models. Some courses will treat the theoretical implications of law regulation from a public international law standpoint and also will discuss the practical administrative aspects of implementing it.

The program also focuses on the critical intersection of data protection, cybersecurity, and the advancements in artificial intelligence (AI), addressing the regulatory challenges and frameworks shaping these domains within the European Union, also examines cybercrime and its impact on society from a criminological perspective.

Participation in the event is free of charge. However, participants are expected to cover the travel, accommodation and living expenses through the Erasmus+ fund available in their home institutions.

Because the working language of all the activities will be English, a minimum B2 level is recommended.

The program is intended for undergraduate, master and PhD students with a minimum B2 level of English proficiency in fields: Cybersecurity, Communication, Administration and Law, or where their credits can be recognized.
