Dear Partners,

Firstly, I would like to express our pleasure in cooperating with you in this blended intensive programme. We believe this programme will not only be beneficial to our students but also contribute to the internationalisation of our institutions and strengthen our academic cooperation.

As time moves on, partnerships are made, and the programme takes a more precise shape. The BIP "Understanding Migration Through Literature" will consist of a virtual component which is before the physical mobility, and a physical component which will take place on 7-11 September 2026 in Trabzon, Türkiye.

As the coordinating university, we would like to describe just the general requirements for the selection procedures of partner universities.

- Bachelor or master degree students in relevant study programmes
- Minimum B1 level proficiency in English

These are the general requirements that we expect selected students to meet. As for the dates and other criteria of the application call, we respect our partner universities' internal rules and expect them to plan for the application call in accordance with their academic calendars. We hope to receive nominations of selected students by the end of March 2026. We expect each partner to nominate 5 students for the programme.

Citizens of EU countries do not require visa to enter Türkiye, which is a great advantage for students, as they will not need to deal with extra bureaucracy and paperwork.

As for accommodation, we have a student dormitory on the campus. We will discuss with the dormitory board to see whether they will have availability. We will communicate further information about accommodation.
