

**Title of BIP:** *Sprachliche und kulturelle Vielfalt im Banat: Geschichte und Gegenwart*

*(Linguistic and Cultural Diversity in the Banat: Past and Present)*

**General information**

**Objectives and Description:**

- Students will expand their knowledge of the linguistic and cultural diversity of the Banat region, while also gaining insights into the topic through the perspectives of the partner universities. In addition, they will deepen their understanding of language and dialects, German-language literature in Romania, and gain an introduction to the cultural history of the local German-speaking minority.

**Methods and outcomes:**

- interactive lectures and expert input
- interdisciplinary workshops (e.g. on language, literature, and memory culture)
- work with authentic materials: literary texts, dialect samples, historical documents
- group work in international teams & guided discussions and reflective sessions
- preparation of short presentations on selected thematic areas & reading of selected academic texts (preparatory and ongoing)
- deeper understanding of linguistic diversity and regional cultures in the Banat
- introduction to the cultural history of the German-speaking minority in Romania
- increased awareness of multilingualism, identity, and memory-related issues
- strengthening of intercultural competence and teamwork skills
- development of a short group output (e.g. presentation or written summary)

**Virtual Component Description:**

The virtual component of the BIP will consist of preparatory and follow-up sessions held online. Before the physical meeting, participants will take part in virtual introductory sessions and have the opportunity to get to know each other before the actual mobility phase. During this phase, students will receive an overview of the programme and work on initial group tasks. Furthermore, they will engage with selected reading materials to prepare for the meeting in Timișoara. These sessions will be led by lecturers from the participating institutions and will include short input presentations, breakout discussions, and collaborative activities. After the mobility phase in Timișoara, a final online meeting will be held, giving students the opportunity to present the results of their group work and to share their experiences.

• **Planned activities during virtual component:**

1<sup>st</sup> online meeting

- introductory meeting, program overview, first input to the Banat, getting-to-know activities, and group formation

2<sup>nd</sup> online meeting

- expert input and discussion of selected preparatory materials, coordination of group tasks for on-site work.

3<sup>rd</sup> online meeting (after physical mobility)

- final discussions and conclusions on the mobility phase, the activities and workshops from Timisoara
- group presentations, reflection, and discussion of further collaboration.

- introductory lecture: Ethnic and linguistic diversity in the Banat region
- thematic impulse from one partner university
- guided city tour: In Search of German/Austrian Traces in Timișoara

- lecture: German-language literature in Romania with a focus on the Banat

- workshop: Dialectal diversity and language contact phenomena in the region
- group work: Analysis of selected literary texts or oral testimonies

- excursion to Gărbâna and Reșița
- workshop: Traces of Language – German Place Names and Linguistic Mapping in Gărbâna and Reșița
- thematic impulse from one partner university

4<sup>th</sup> day:

- transfer to Reșița
- meeting with Erwin Țigla and visit to the Democratic Forum of the Banat Mountain Germans
- reading or literary discussion with local authors
- thematic impulse from one partner university
- return to Timișoara in the late afternoon

5<sup>th</sup> day:

- Group presentations: *Topics developed during the week*
- Final roundtable: *Multilingualism, regional heritage and future perspectives*
- Cultural program: Visit to the German State Theatre in Timișoara
