

This autumn, we will launch the second edition of the **EU Foundation Training Week**, a practice-based professional development event hosted by the University of Latvia in Riga. This initiative is designed to directly support higher education institutions in strengthening the implementation of internationalisation activities through hands-on, skills-oriented training.

- aspects of mobility implementation, from tools and processes to emerging trends and opportunities. The training is offered in two iterations: one for early-career staff (less than 3 years of experience in International Relations Offices) and one for more experienced
- colleagues (more than 3 years).

- **(26–28 October 2026)**, designed for experienced practitioners
- navigating the challenges of the lump sum funding model. This track focuses on planning, partner alignment, and project delivery, offering practical tools and strategies to manage complexity effectively.

- **(28-30 October 2026)** aimed at senior internationalisation
- professionals and Heads of International Relations Offices, focusing on moving from operational management to a more integrated strategic approach to internationalisation.

Participants from the first edition highlighted how valuable the experience was in terms of new skills, practical ideas, and peer exchange, as well as the renewed sense of connection across the Erasmus+ community.
