Join us for an intensive Erasmus Staff Week at Eötvös Loránd University in Budapest, Hungary, where we tackle one of higher education's most pressing challenges: the rise of artificial intelligence! This staff week is not about quick fixes or tech tutorials – it's a forward-thinking program designed to empower educators to respond strategically and responsibly to AI-driven change.

GOAL OF THE WEEK

Most institutional responses to AI default to either uncritical adoption (vendor-led "tips and tricks") or futile resistance (surveillance and detection). This course provides a pedagogical approach to ensure the quality and integrity of learning. Participants will shift their focus from tactical "prompt engineering" to the cultivation of "Executive Cognition", and learn to design AI-resilient assessments, deploy rigorous verification protocols for research, and draft localized governance policies.
