The BIP combines an online introduction with an intensive in-person experience. During the programme, you will:

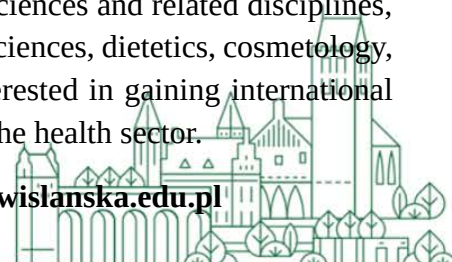
- attend lectures delivered by international experts,
