

1. The candidate selects the study program from WUT's offer and submits the application file (for Bachelor's Degree Studies the application file can also be submitted online)

5. Each admitted candidate must confirm their study place obtained, by sending to DIR a letter of confirmation, available on the website, according to the admission calendar of the faculty in WUT.

9. NME issues Tuition Letters for the "Foreign citizens of Romanian Origin" admitted for studies at WUT.

2. DIR forwards the application file to the faculty in WUT, for the admission process (for Bachelor Degree Studies)

Or

The candidate presents the application file, verified and approved by DIR, at the faculty in WUT, for the admission process (for Master Degree Studies)

6. After centralizing all letters of confirmation the faculty in WUT makes a new ranking of the admitted candidates and communicates the final results to DIR.

10. The student is enrolled at the faculty in WUT by submitting original documents in their enrollment file and the Tuition Letter.

3. The faculty in WUT evaluates all submitted application files and makes a ranking of the candidates, according to grades and the available study places and communicates the results to DIR.

7. DIR posts on the website the final results of the admission for every faculty in WUT.

4. DIR posts on the website the ranking of the candidates for every faculty in WUT

8. DIR communicates to NME the final results of the admission of "Foreign citizens of Romanian Origin" at WUT.
